- 6레벨 Leo (과거형을 사용하며, 사고력 향상을 목표)
- 7레벨 Kiri (과거형을 사용하며, 깊은 사고력 관련 포함)

They are clean again.

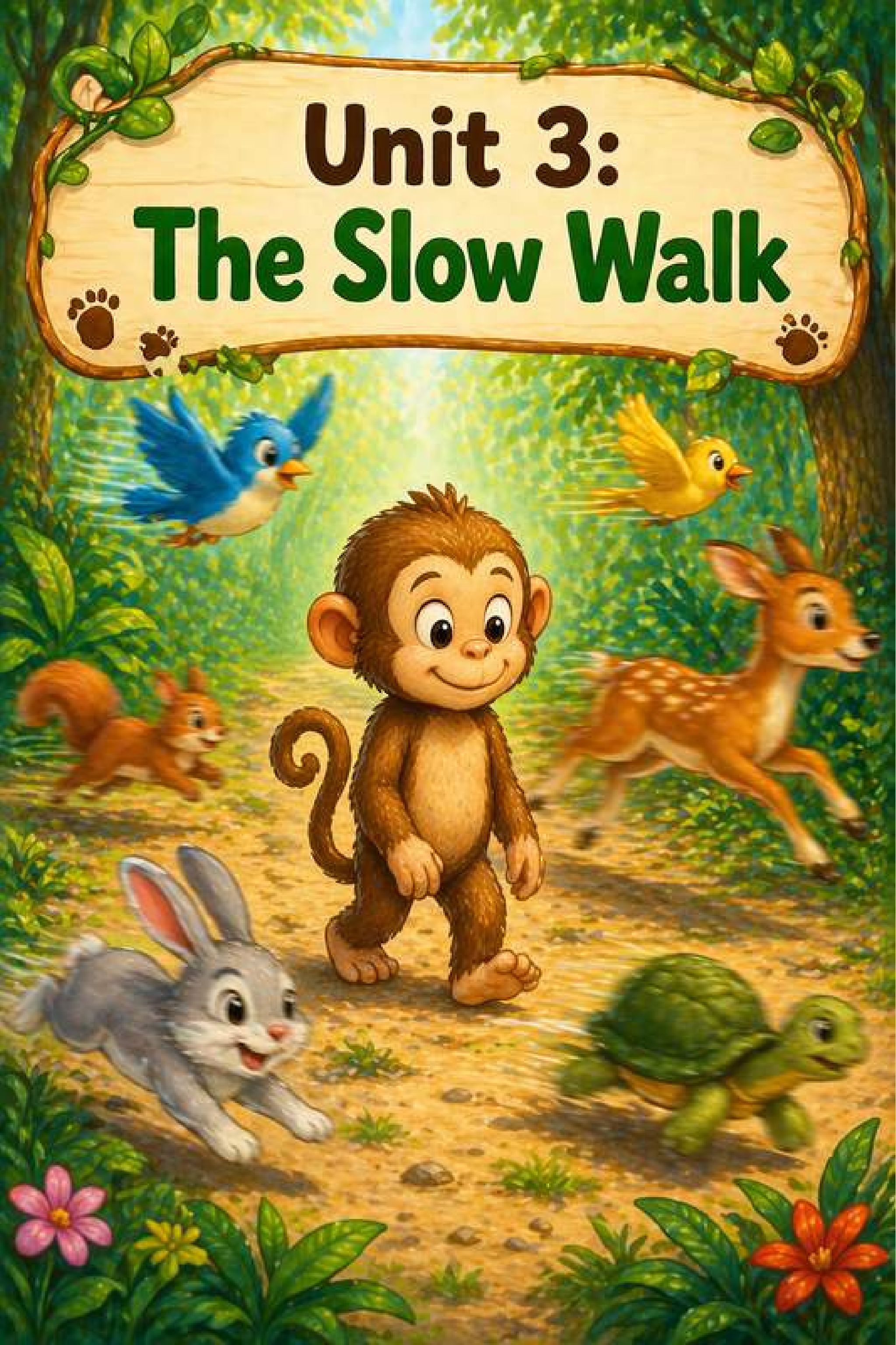
Momo smiles.

“Oh no!” Momo says.



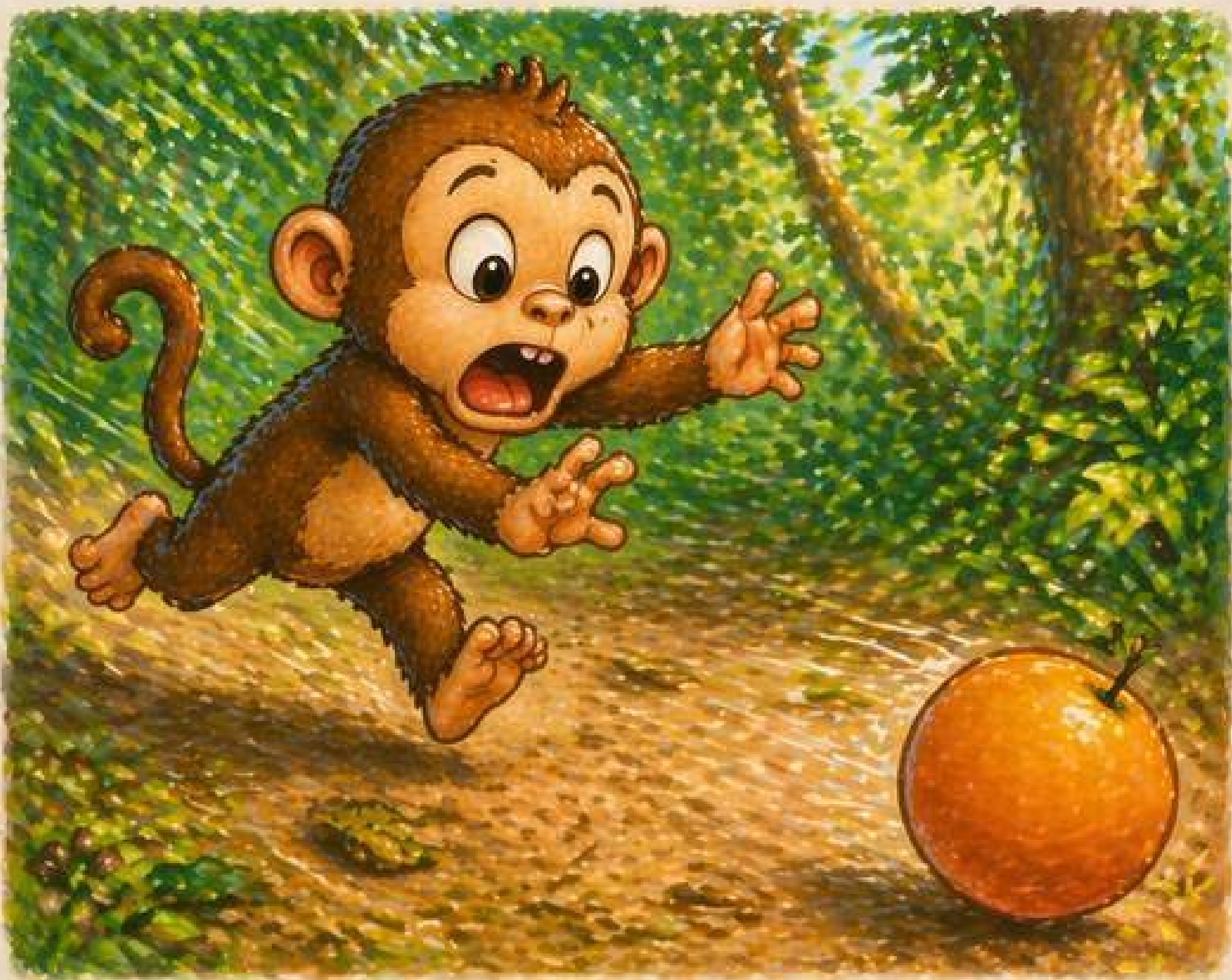
1 What happens to the fruit?

It rolls fast and far.

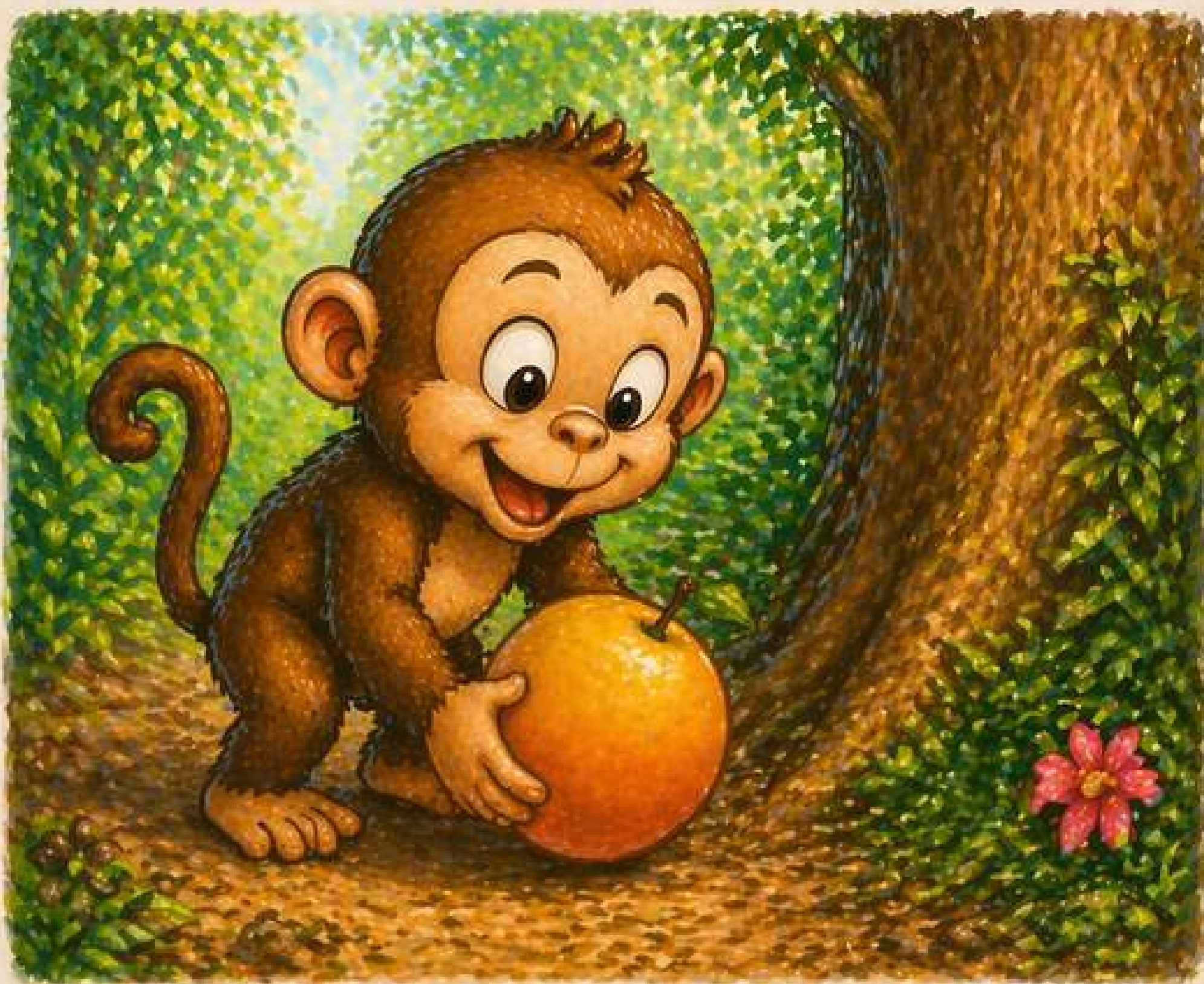
“Wait!” Momo says.

He sits quietly.



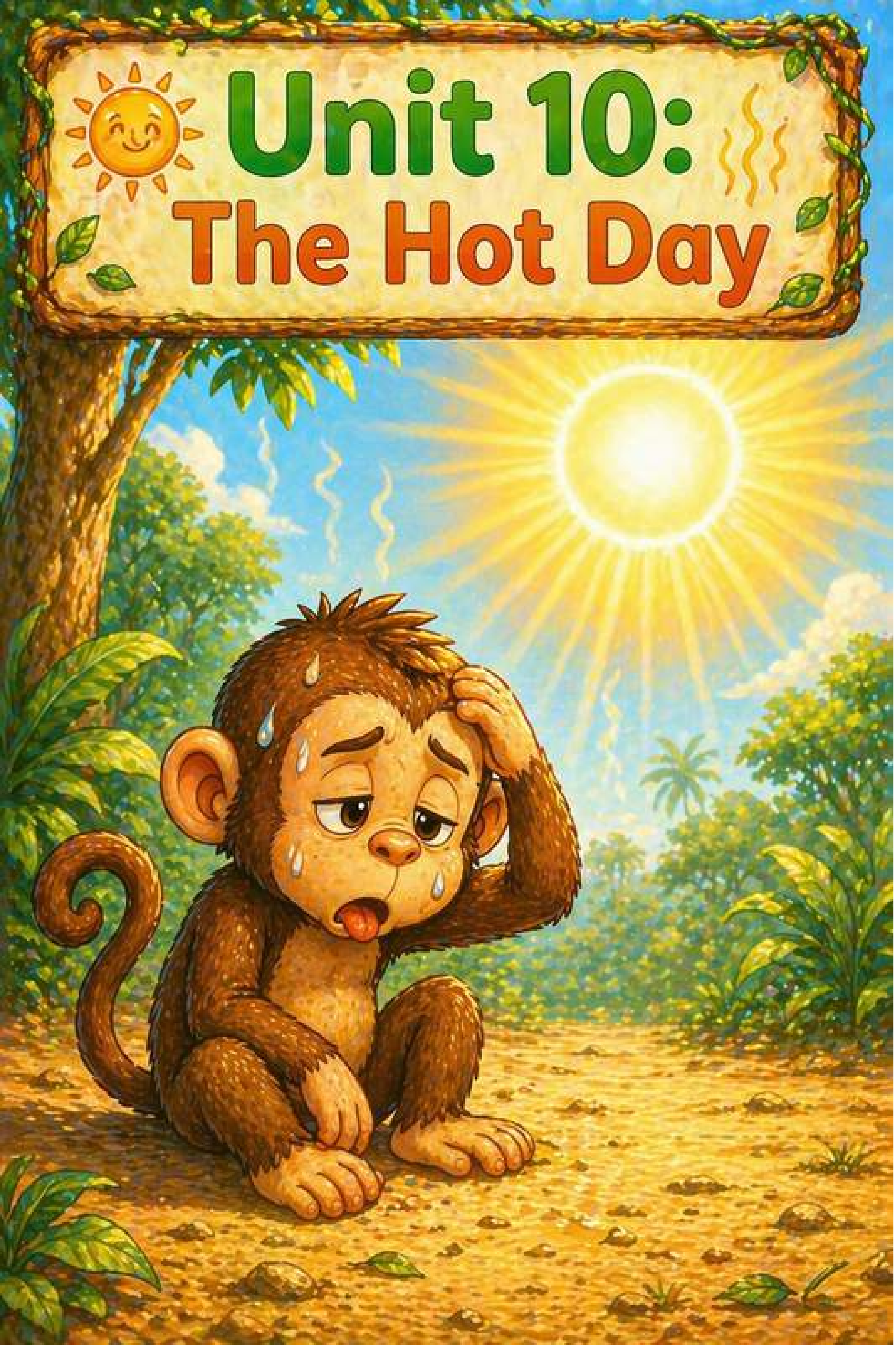

The sun is bright and strong.

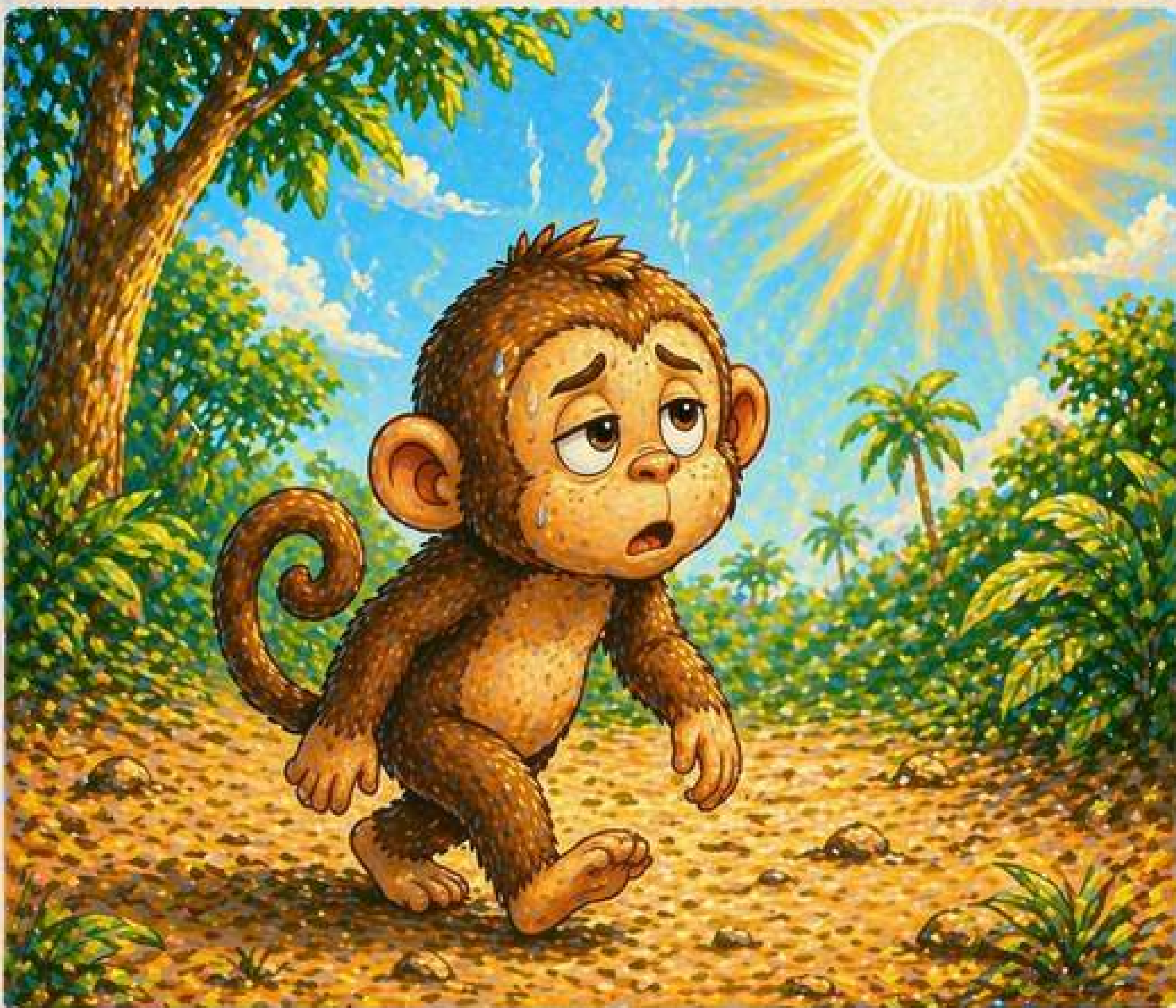
“Hot!” Momo says.

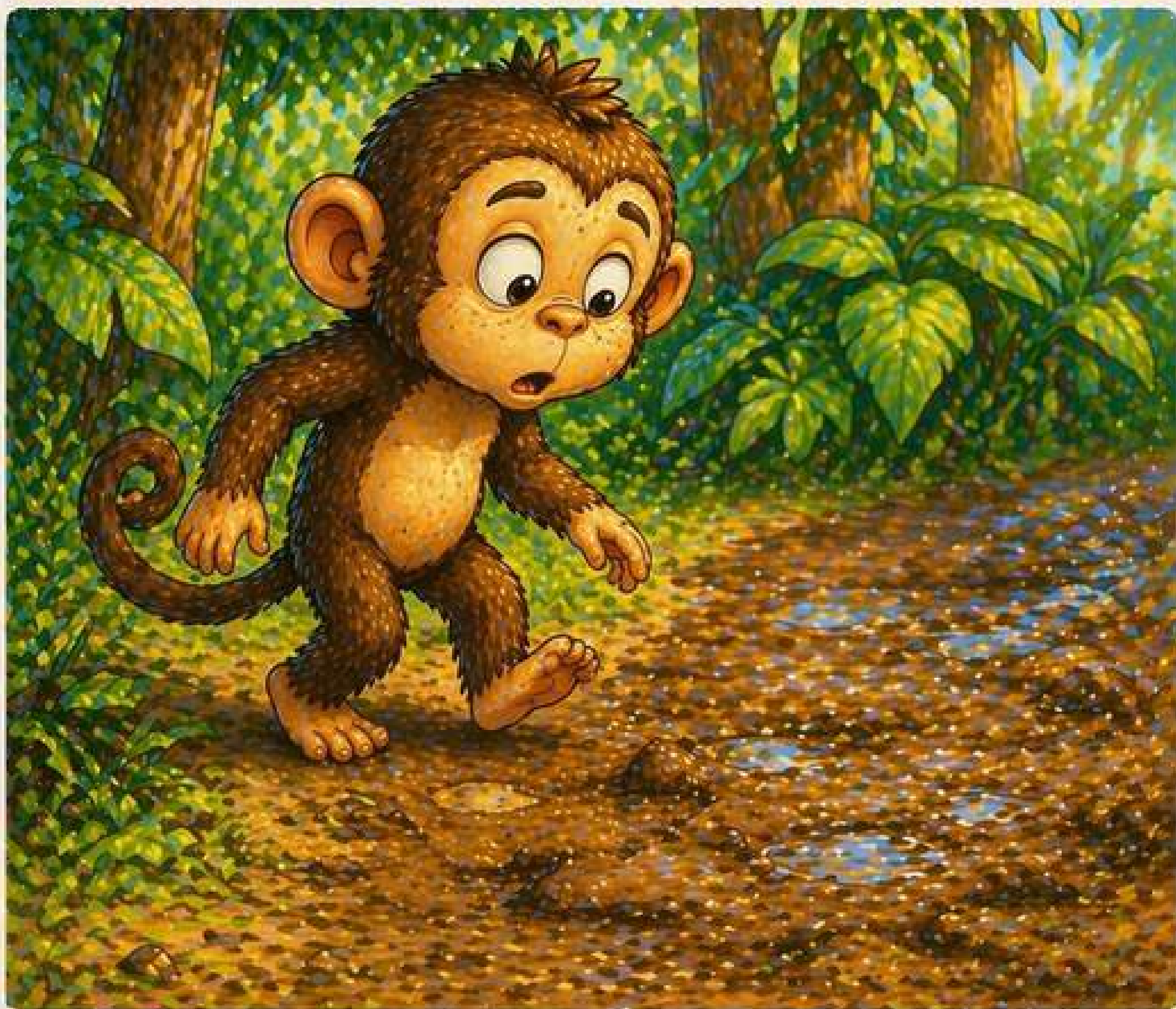
Unit 11: The Stuck Foot

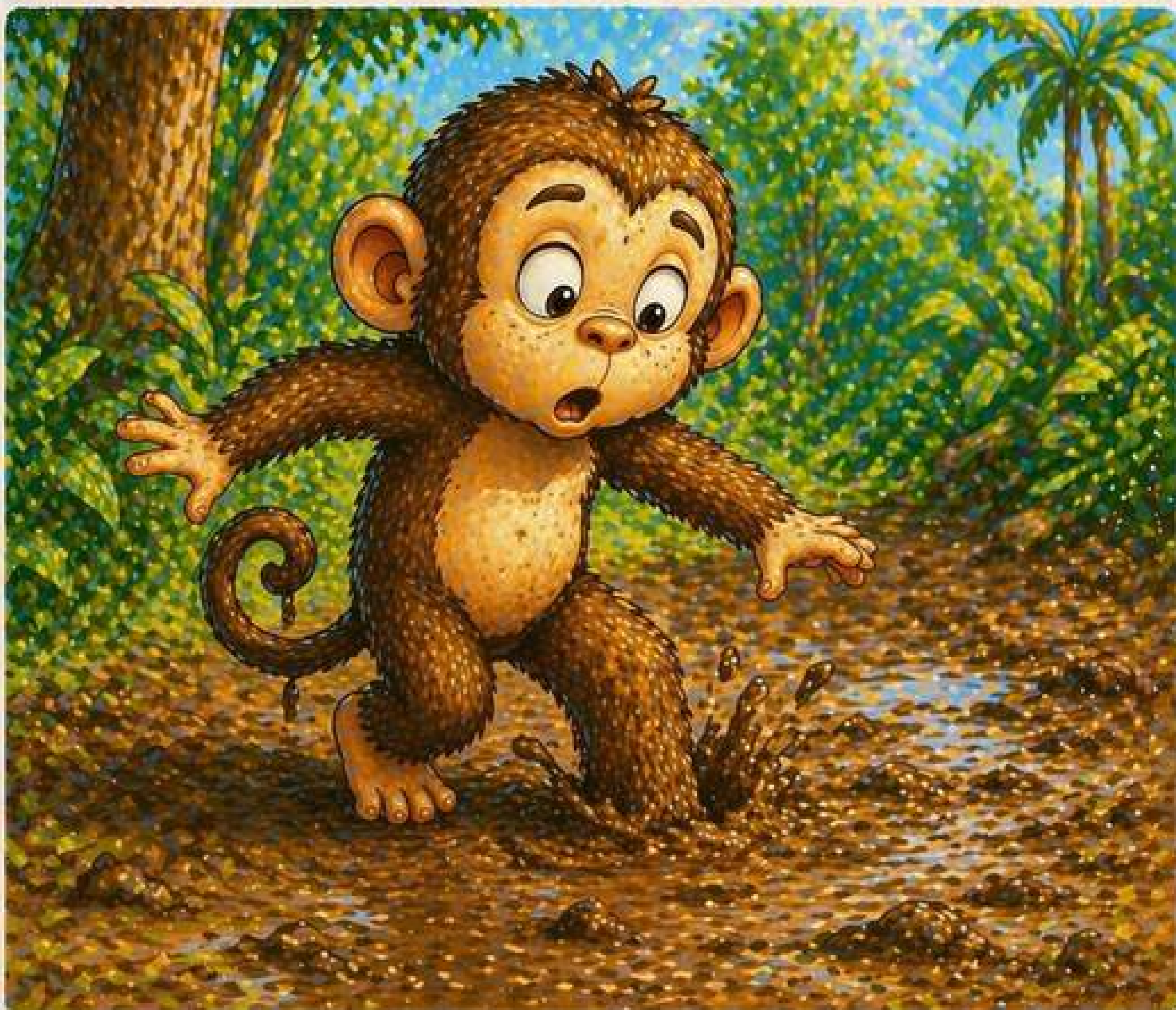

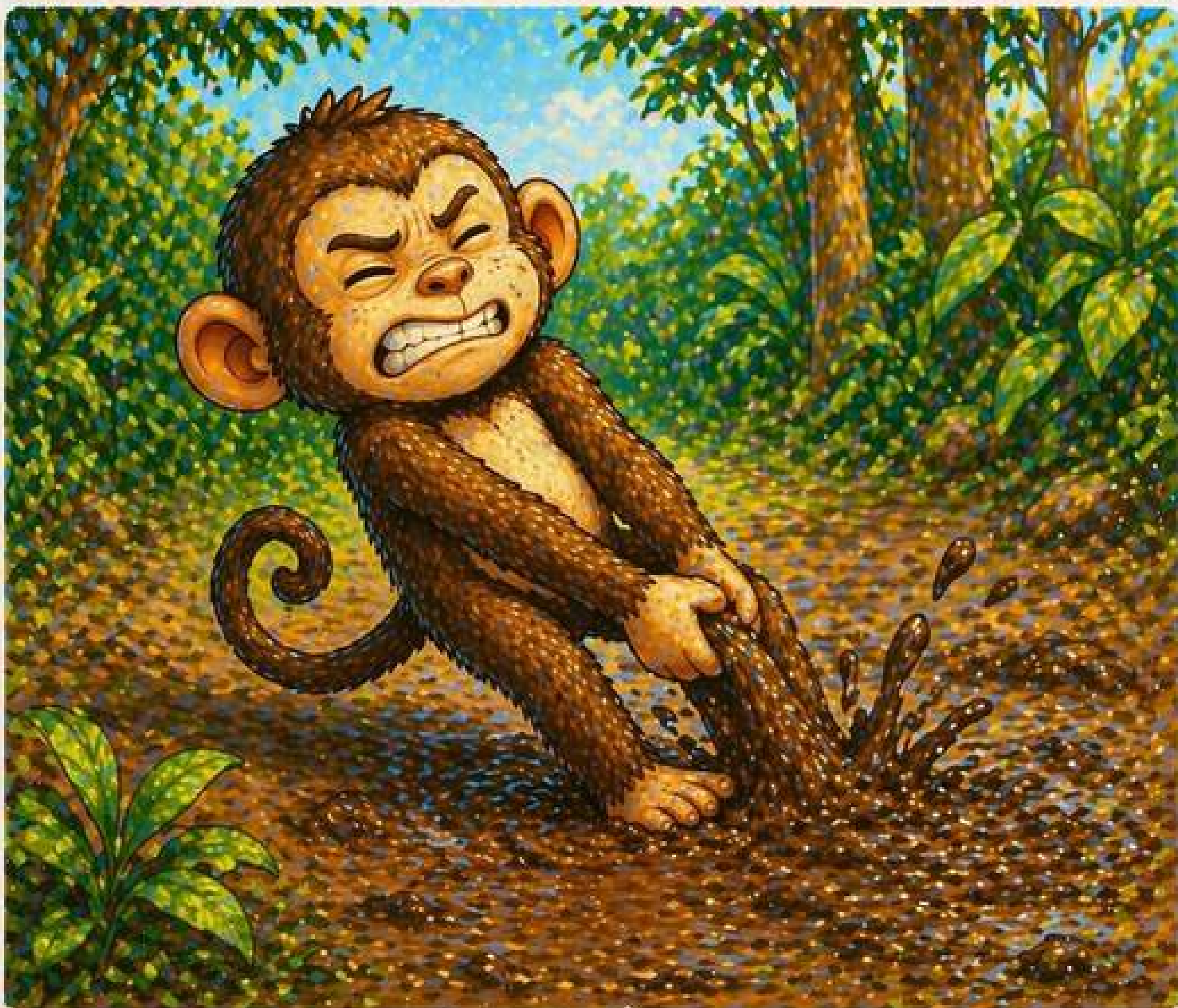
